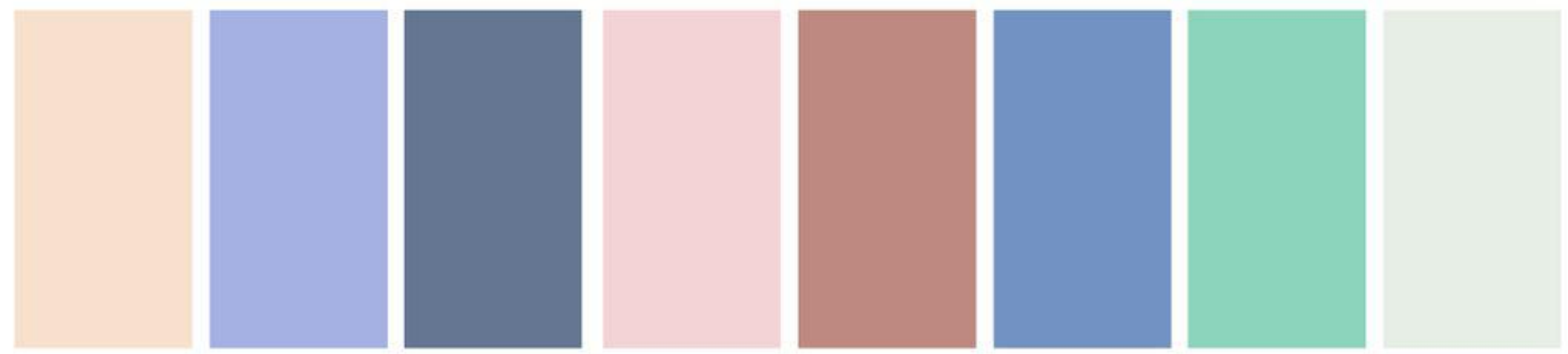
Ice Haven

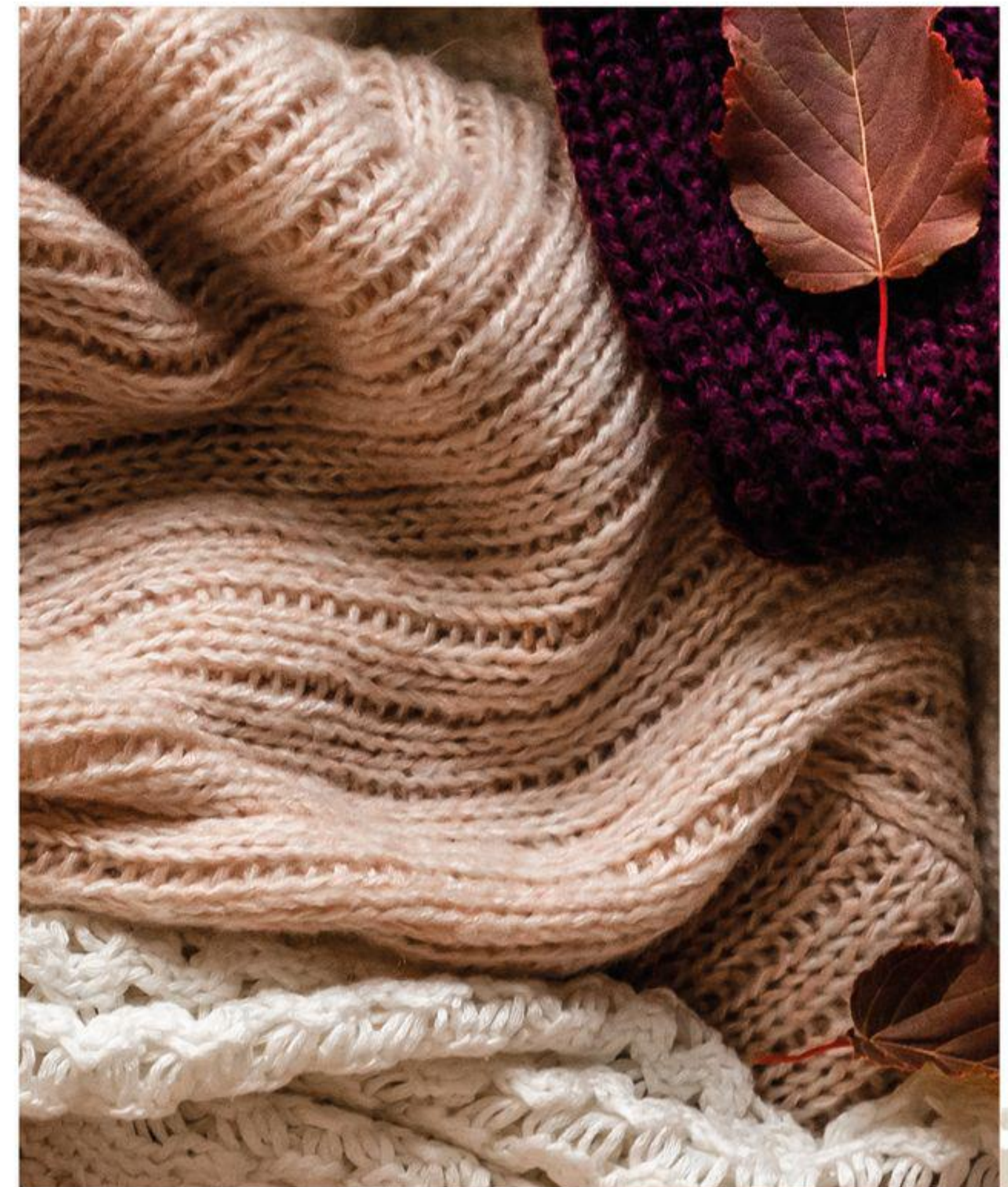

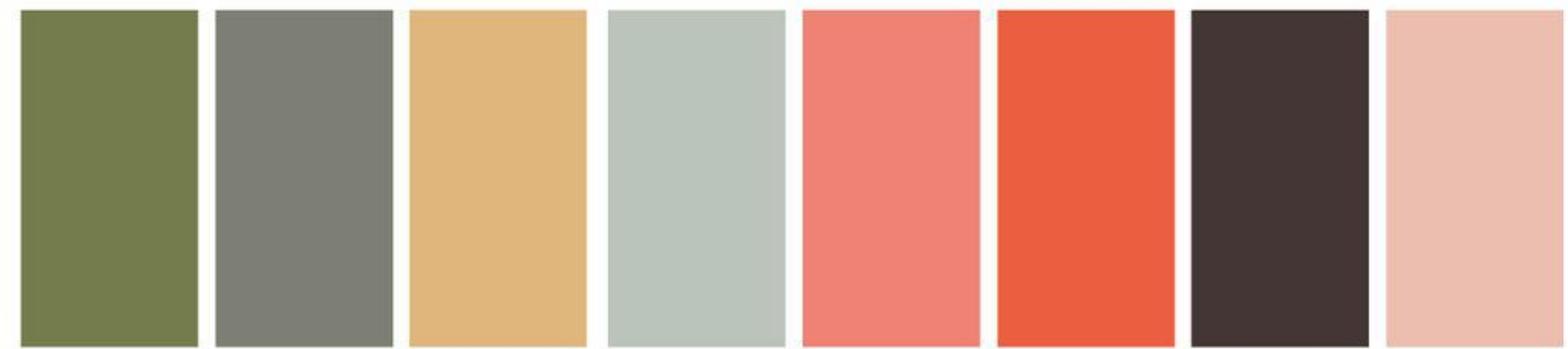
The trend here is for consumers to remove themselves from the social media focused world, and create an intimate, cocoon in their home. Everything has a raw, functional feel being simple and practical.

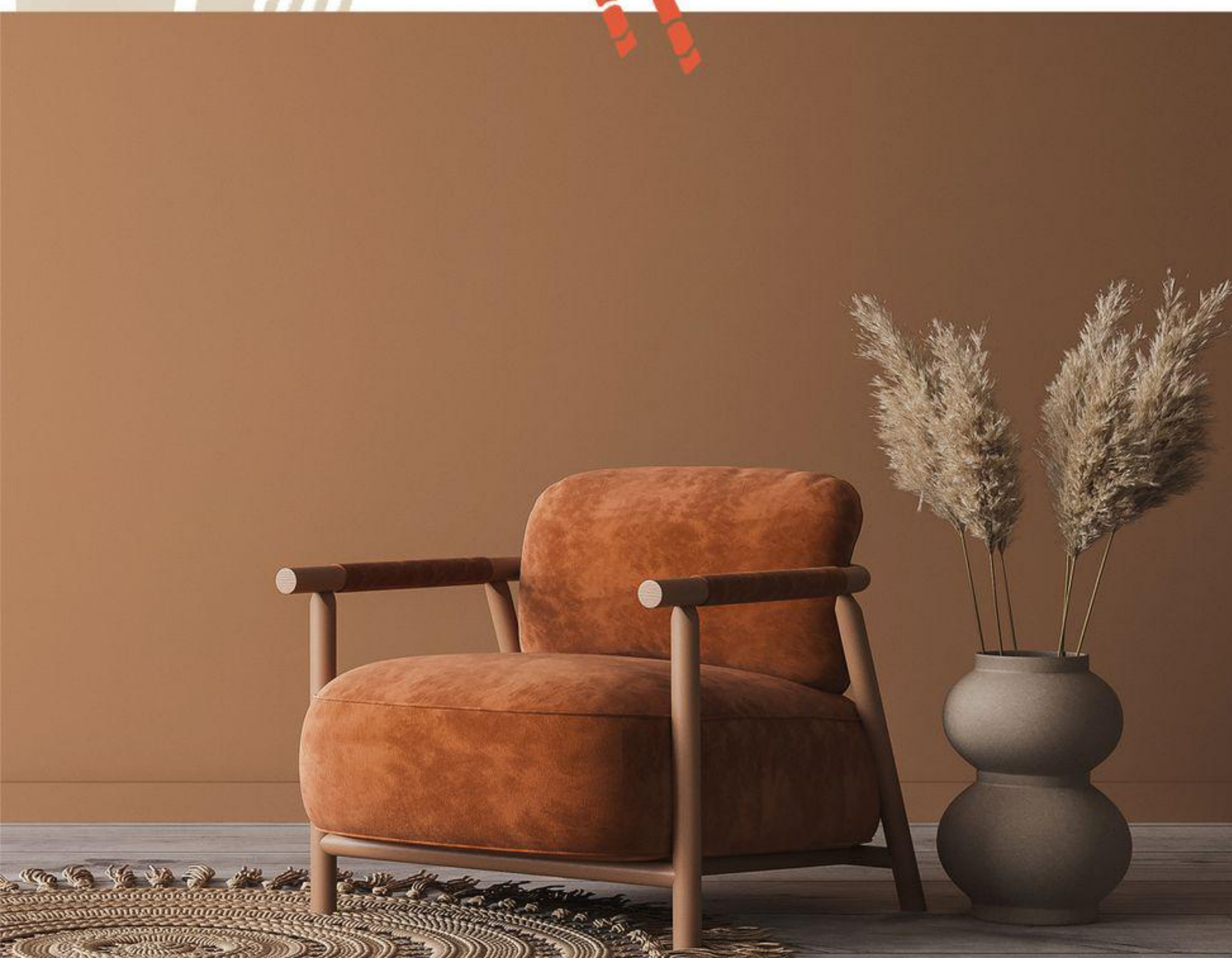
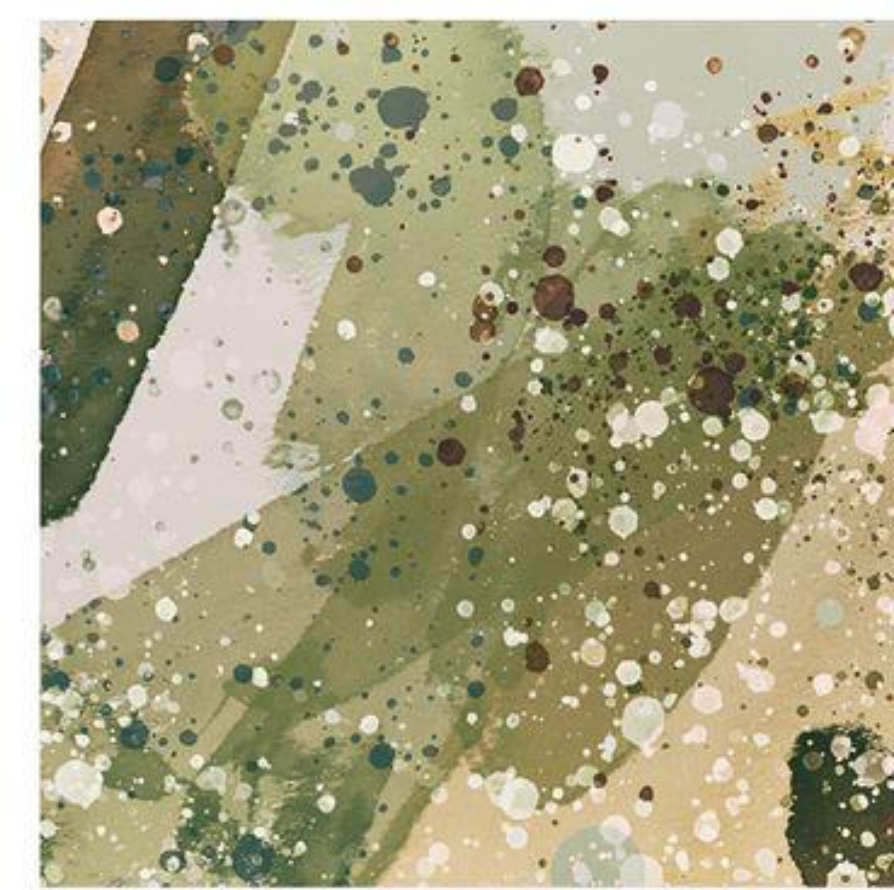

Wood Chestnut



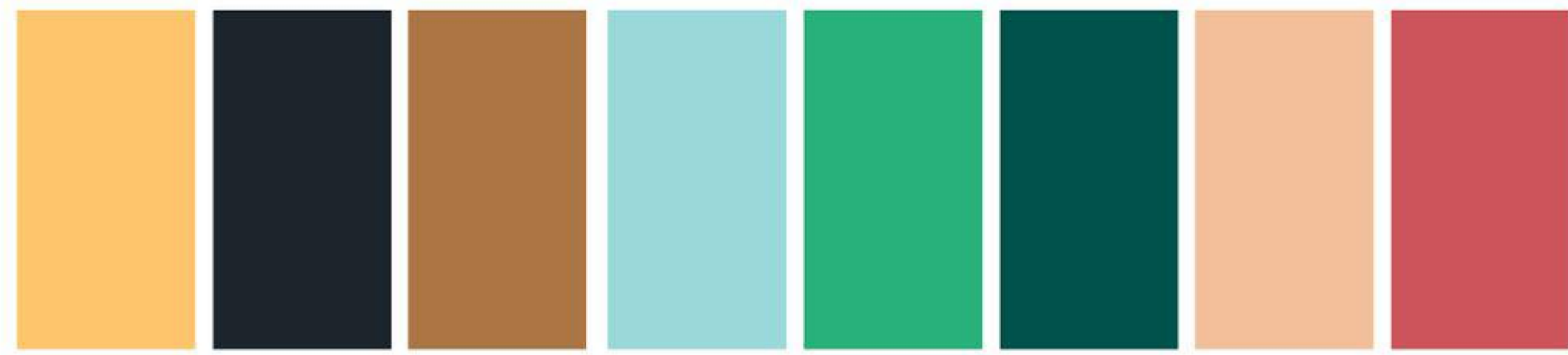
JOYFUL GATHERING
